## UPRIVER CONCERNS

### River Watch - Safety & Rescue Beersville Fire Department

The Fire Department is concerned that not all access points to the river are identified for water rescue and we need your help! We are in the 1<sup>st</sup> phase of confirming all access points along the river in the event of an emergency. Attached is a map of the vast network of the river system – as you can see, knowing in advance which access points would

provide the best entry to the river could make a difference in emergency response times. We have been very fortunate that water rescue has not been an issue with the increased activity of boaters and water crafts on the river in recent years. However, in the event of an accident we want to be ready and prepared.



### How you can help:

The Beersville Fire Department invites you to submit your access point location if you own a residence, cottage or a lot along the river. If you require further information on this initiative or would like to volunteer, please contact: The Beersville Fire Department at (which contact name and number.)

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of some key safety tips:

- \*Always wear a safety approved life jacket when on the river.
- \*Do not let children play around any water without adult supervision.
- \*Have a telephone close by in the event of an emergency.
- \*Keep safety & rescue equipment handy.

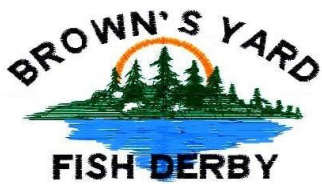
